- aim to attend school every day but let the school know on the first day if your child is absent from school.
- to communicate with the school any special medical needs, or any special circumstances at home that may affect your child's learning
- attend the parent consultation evenings and support your child with his/her homework.

- be polite and respectful to others in school.
