

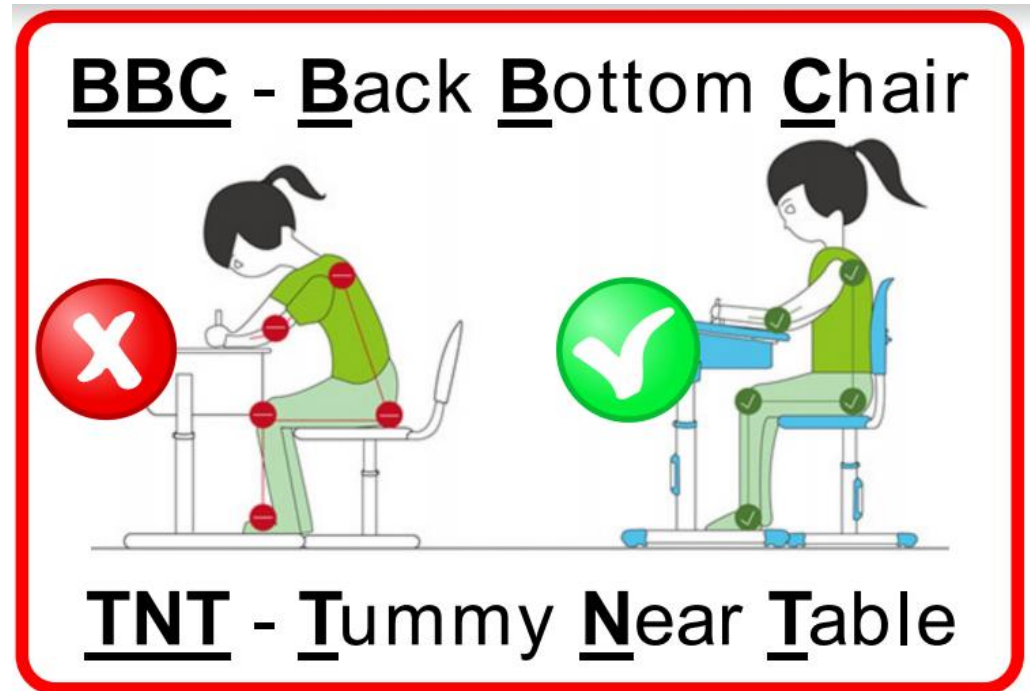
# Behaviour Policy 2021

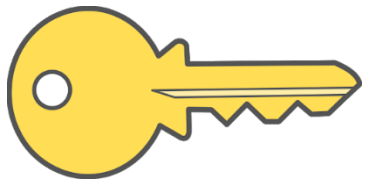

**Visible Consistency, Visible Kindness**

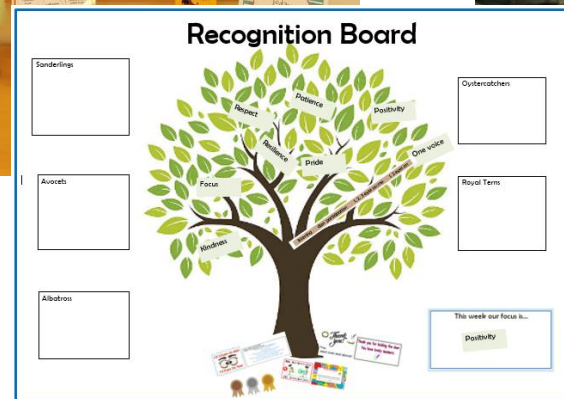
