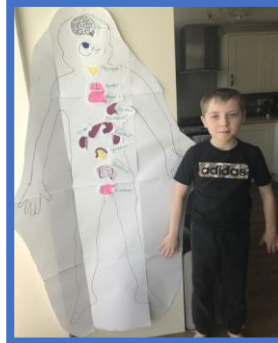
Staying in Touch with Class Dojo

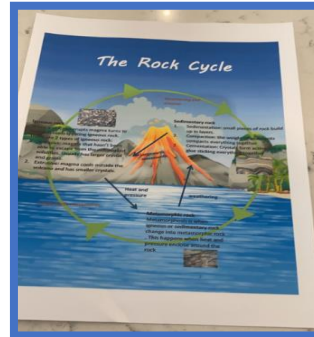
Uniform
